### The Village derby car making rules:

- The axles, wheels, and body shall be from the kit only.
- The total car width is not to exceed 3 inches.
- The axle width cannot be modified.
- The diameter of the wheels may not be changed.
- Weights may be added.
- The weight is not to exceed 8 oz.
- There cannot be loose parts.
- The axles may be lubricated with silicone or graphite.
