It's spring again and many of us are doing projects around the yard and home. Contact the town if you have too much debris to put into your garbage can. Disposing of yard waste along the alleys or on property that is not yours is not appropriate.

Some questions have arisen as to when does a project need to have a review by our VARC (Village Architectural Review Committee). The answers can be found in "The Village Book". This is the set of guidelines which apply to our neighborhood. This can be accessed through the website <u>-vbhpoa.com</u>

Some of the common questions include:

Do I need approval to paint my exterior trim? Only if you are changing the color, if painting the same color, you are good to go.

Can I change my siding? Painting the same color is fine. Changing the color or the material requires approval.

Can I tear out all my landscaping and just plant grass? No. All homes are required to have a certain amount of landscaping facing the street.

Can I put up a fence? Yes, but it does need approval from the VARC. There are guidelines for color, style and placement. Modification forms are available on the website vbhpoa.com.

As the weather warms up and there is more outdoor activity, please watch out for youngsters.
