
2022 ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Burns Harbor has been upgrading the roadway infrastructure over the past few years, and the Town has received grant approval from INDOT's Community Crossing Matching Grant Program for roadway reconstruction or repaving this season that may affect your neighborhood.

COMMUNITY GARDENS

Community Garden plots are available at the following rates:

- Large garden plots: \$25/season (reduced price for shorter guaranteed season)
- Small garden plots: \$12/season (reduced price for shorter guaranteed season)

Only organic methods are allowed in the individual garden plots.

Water is provided.

Since the gardens are on a lot that is slated for development in the near

future, the guaranteed season will be shorter this year. Use of the garden plots is assured through August 31, 2022. After that, gardeners may continue with their gardens at their own risk. The lot may be affected by the construction.
