

## Village POA Meeting

### Meeting Minutes

5-13-2021

- 1) Meeting was called to order at 7:07. Meeting was at the Triangle Park.
- 2) Attending were Melissa Hamilton, Wilbur Oudman, Angel Bernahl and Sarah Oudman.
- 3) Minutes of the April 8, 2021 meeting were approved.
- 4) Welcome Baskets – Angel is working on getting Welcome Baskets to new neighbors. She has 7 remaining.
- 5) Banner Contest – No entries were received for the Banner Contest. Angel will check with Trinity Displays about designing a new Banner. We will stick with the green background with “Welcome “and logo. Angel will ask if the “wind slits” are necessary.
- 6) May Village Fun Night – There will be a Scavenger Hunt and a Food Truck (Deep Blue Sea). The prizes for the Scavenger Hunt will be vouchers for the Food Truck. \$15 for the 1<sup>st</sup> place team and \$10 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Wilbur will print the vouchers and Melissa will print the Hunt directions.
