BRUSH PICKUP CONTINUES

Tree branches are to be no longer than 6 feet long and no larger than 6 inches in diameter. Please pile

your brush so that the cut ends are in the same direction. All materials are to be placed on the Town's right-of-way, close to the edge of the pavement.

In case of inclement weather, brush will be picked up as soon as the weather allows.

The Street Department cannot collect root balls, garden waste, or vines of any kind because these items can damage their equipment. You can bring these items, as well as garden waste, to the brush bin behind the Street Department, but they must be able to fit inside the bin. **Grass clippings and leaves are not accepted.** If you are unsure whether your organic material can be brought in, please call 219.787.9187.

FALL LEAF PICKUP RETURNS

Residents should pile leaves in the town right-of-way along the pavement for pick up. Please do not put leaves in ditches and be sure your leaves are clear of sticks, debris, and pet waste. Leaf pick-up will continue every Tuesday through December 5, weather permitting. Note that it may take more than one day per week to collect the leaves.

In the case of inclement weather, the leaves will be picked up as soon as the weather allows.
